

Key Concepts in S3


- Smart Specialisation Strategy is the system of objectives and tools for helping the region's knowledge based development taking into account needs and challenges in order to foster <u>structural change</u> such that capitalises on strengths, competitive advantages and potentials over the strategic horizon.
- Entrepreneurial discovery process (EDP): By continuous and systematic observation and analysis of the changes in regional economy and society, and by actively involving a wide range of stakeholders, today's decisions about future innovations that bring about sustained development for the region are made with an entrepreneurial eye.
 - ENTREPRENEURIAL EYE ≠ EXCLUSIVELY ENTREPRENEURS → INTERACTIONS!
- EDP leads to structural change.
