The Fulbright Program

- Binational higher educational exchange program, supported by the U.S. and partner countries' governments and sponsors (private and institutional)
- Founded worldwide in 1946
- Number of participating countries: 167
- Number of grantees between 1946 2016 above 380,000
- 140,844 U.S. citizens, 246,709 non-U.S. in 1946-2016

1978 Hungary joins the Fulbright program
1992 The Fulbright Commission was founded

Hungarian Fulbright's primary goals

- Development of the Hungarian and U.S. higher education
- Promoting international education, building ties among U.S. and Hungarian institutions
- Promoting new initiatives in innovation and knowledge transfer

Research
 3-5 months

Lecturing
 3-5 months

Combined (lecture-research)
 3-5 months

Graduate studies, independent

projects, PhD research 6 months - 1 academic year

Special grants short or long term

Subject fields: All subject fields; priority identified annually by the Board

Host institutions: All accredited higher educational, academic and research institutions

Selection: Open competition, selection based on merit, academic and professional excellence, and leadership potential

Fulbright Program offers

- Thorough knowledge of the Hungarian and U.S. higher education
- Assistance during application, and placement procedure, host contact
- Orientation, administrative assistance before, during and after, the grant period
- Professional enhancement opportunities
- Assistance in setting up professional contacts, supporting personal and institutional development efforts
- Lively, active contact with alumni, long term follow-up, alumni grants and care
- Reputation, appreciation and respect

Grant covers

 Living costs, 50% of travel costs, insurance, dependent allowance, tuition up to USD 15,000.

Fulbrighters are highly qualified professionals, leaders in the scientific, cultural, and governmental spheres.

- Core program (lecturers, researchers, experts, students)
- Senior Specialist Program: U.S. experts, 42 days maximum
- Scholar-in-Residence Program: Hungarian expert, academic year

- Participating in student advising, mentoring
- Curriculum and courseware development, introducing new subjects, and teaching methods
- Helping new initiatives
