Eligibility

- Coordinator: only legal entities established in widening countries
- Universities in EUN can participate but excluded from receiving funding



☐ Aims at the transformation of HE sector and their surrounding ecosystems, including non-university research centres.

Specific outcomes:

- **Cooperation between** the partner **HEIs** in the network, and with actors in **surrounding ecosystems**, jointly creating **critical mass** to contribute better to **major** societal challenges
- preparations to **embark** onto the potential future European Universities initiative

Expected outcome (1)



- ☐ successful **cooperation models for** modernisation/transformation at R&I level
- □act as a regional role model of successful transformation
- ☐ facilitate **future synergies** between the **EEA and the ERA**, in particular in relation to the EUN alliances
- ☐ Pending the evaluation of the European Universities pilot portfolio in 2021-2022, the EEI in 2021 will focus on capacity building for networks of higher education institutions and partners in the local ecosystem, with a view of preparing the networks towards the full roll-out of the European Universities initiative in the years to come.

Scope

- significantly strengthening cooperation between at least two organisations from higher education sector in a Widening country /countries
- with at least two internationally-leading institutions from two different MS / AC

Strategy with a shared agenda to

- a) develop R&I strategies and roadmaps with impact for society
- b) preparing the NW towards the establishment of a EUN alliance (or similar)
- c) strengthening attractiveness of researchers' careers, including reform in career assessment
- d) co-operation with surrounding ecosystem actors for the transmission of knowledge and talents, e.g. through creation / reinforcing of technology transfer offices and cooperation platforms

- e) transition to knowledge- and digitally-driven universities, conducting Open Science
- f) creating proximity to and engaging citizens for solving societal challenges
- g) supporting institutional change through inclusive gender equality plans
 - Enhance the scientific and technological capacity of the linked institutions with a principal focus on the entities from the WiC(s)
 - Help raise the excellence profile of the HEI from WiC and the excellence profile of its staff
 - 3. Strengthen the NWs towards realising integrated cooperation between the participating entities in the R&I dimension, in synergy with the entities' education and training missions
