BMBF EUREKA calls

Policy goals

Foster technological cooperation with strong partners from Central and Eastern European countries

Fund measures that...

- lead to marketable innovations
- have large market potential in Germany, Hungary and Europe

Policy shift

- from R&D networks (university cooperation and consortia)
- to market oriented innovation
- more important role for SMEs



EUREKA basic requirements

(Reminder)

Minimum consortium: German and Hungarian SME
- independent companies

Project result

- marketable product, process or service with civilian purpose
- product, process or service: innovative and a technological risk involved

Cooperation

- on an equal base: balanced contribution within the project
- project should have an obvious advantage and added value resulting from the technological cooperation



BMBF funding opportunity

Funding in Germany

Scope

- max. 300.000 Euro funding (=50%)
- max. 36 months duration

Funded resources

- Personnel
- Consumables
- Travel, Workshop, Other

In case: further German partner(s)

- university or research organisation: 100% funding



BMBF national regulations

Requirements

Submission of proposal to EUREKA Bureau (step 1)
EUREKA form by e-mail
by 30 May 2018

1. EUREKA form

- e.g. overall project idea, technological development envisaged, market description
- pdf-file with signature

2. Additional project description

by e-mail, by 30 May
German or English



Additional project description

Expected Results

- Economic and social impact of the project results
- Achievement of a critical mass and better use of limited resources in fields of mutual interest
- Mutual access to cross-border and European value chains
- Rough budget allocations, i.e. estimated percentages for personnel, travel, material, consumables



Next steps

DLR Agency

- Collect proposals after submission deadline (June->)
- Carry out the national evaluation procedure
- Decide and discuss ranking list with NKFIH (Aug->)
- Jointly select the most promising projects
- Invite coordinators of selected project to full proposal (step 2, Sep->)
- Prepare EUREKA labelling and endorsement (Oct->)



Next steps

German proposers

- Develop your initial idea
 - Discuss it and find a Hungarian partner
 - Clarify further submission details with DLR Agency
 - Submit proposal – complete and in time
 - Hopefully: receive the invitation for step-2-application
- ... and start the „real work“ in 2019!
