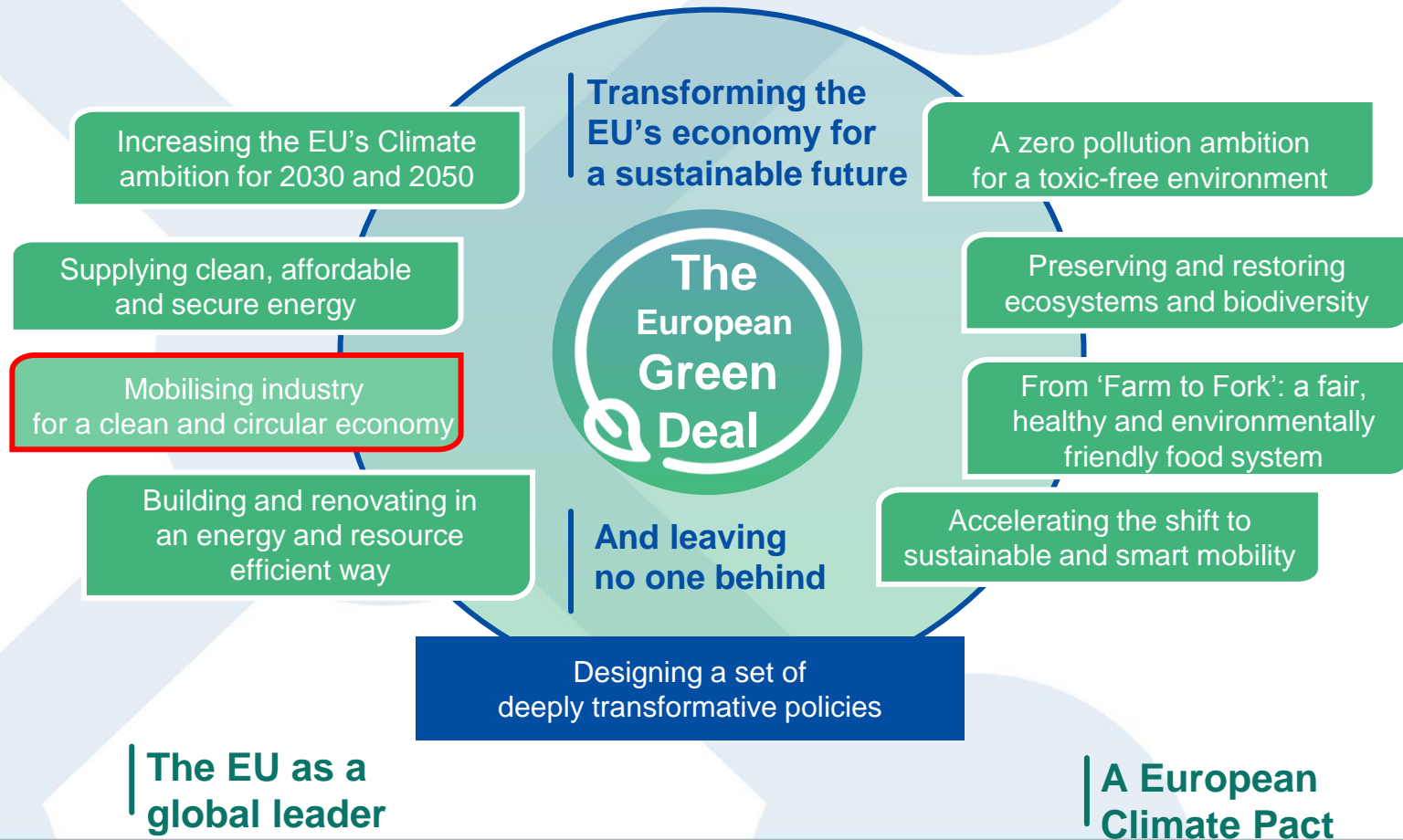

The Green Deal Call

- Directly relevant to the Green Deal objectives
- Aim:
 - to produce tangible results,
 - visible to the citizens,
 - in a relatively short time frame.
- To increase impact and visibility, proposed actions should be limited in number supporting primarily innovation and demonstration actions.
- Emphasis would be given to systemic, cross-sectoral approaches. Take-up of Council recommendations (10/12/2019) to use the approach on *transformative change of the UN SDG report*
