# Call 1: MIGRATION

- 4 új felhívás: 2 RIA, 2 IA, 1 CSA
- 100 M Eur költségvetés 3 évre, összesen 27 projektre tervezve
- Cél a európai kormányzatok támogatása a globális migrációs problémák kezelésében, innovatív megoldási javaslatok a migrációs folyamatok irányításában, társadalmi integrációkban.
- 4 téma: az új migrációs hullám társadalmi és gazdasági hatásai Európára, integrációs kihívások (helyi közösségekbe történő integrálás), migráns gyermekek integrációs kihívásainak feltérképezése és megoldása; a média, a politika és más nyilvános narratívák hatása a migráció megítélésére; fenntartható gyakorlatok az újonnan érkezett migránsok társadalomba történő beilleszkedése érdekében)
