

Help the DIHs to unlock their collaboration and networking potential via **mentoring**, **coaching and co-creating activities**, mainly dedicated to collaboration





Technology-driven

DIHs whose services are oriented to **improve the technical capacity of clients in relation to AI technology**.




AI DIH Network – Collaboration experiences within the project
