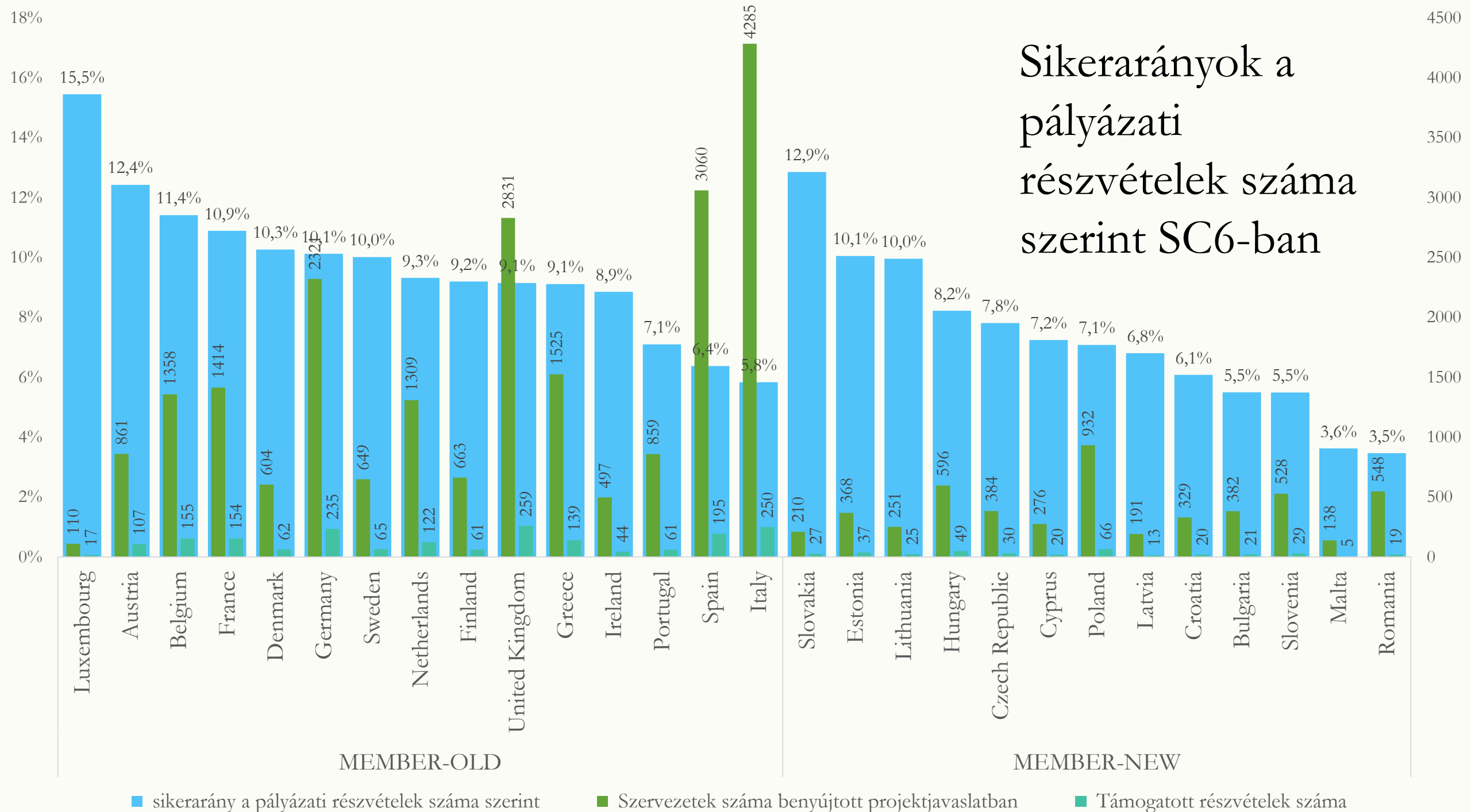

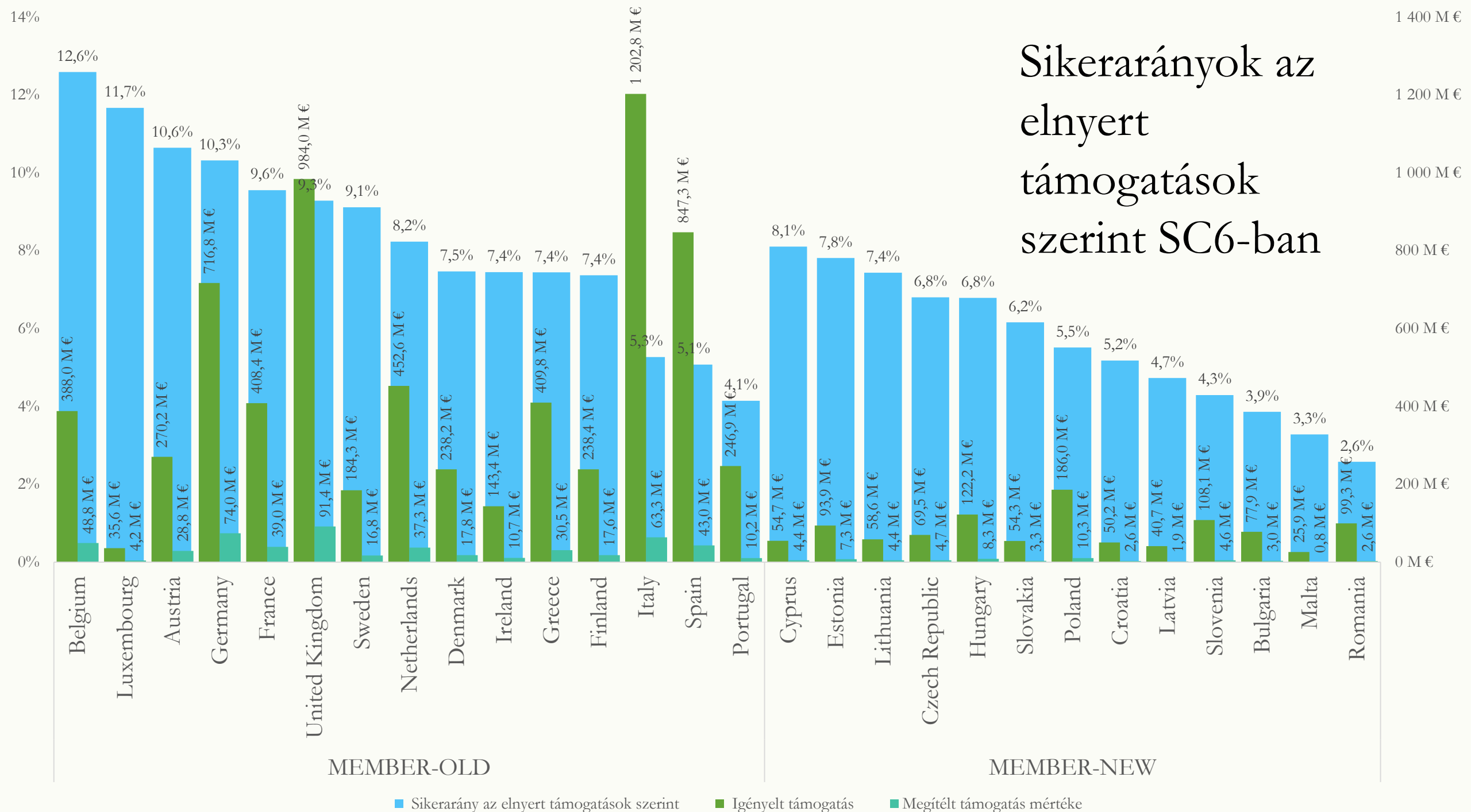

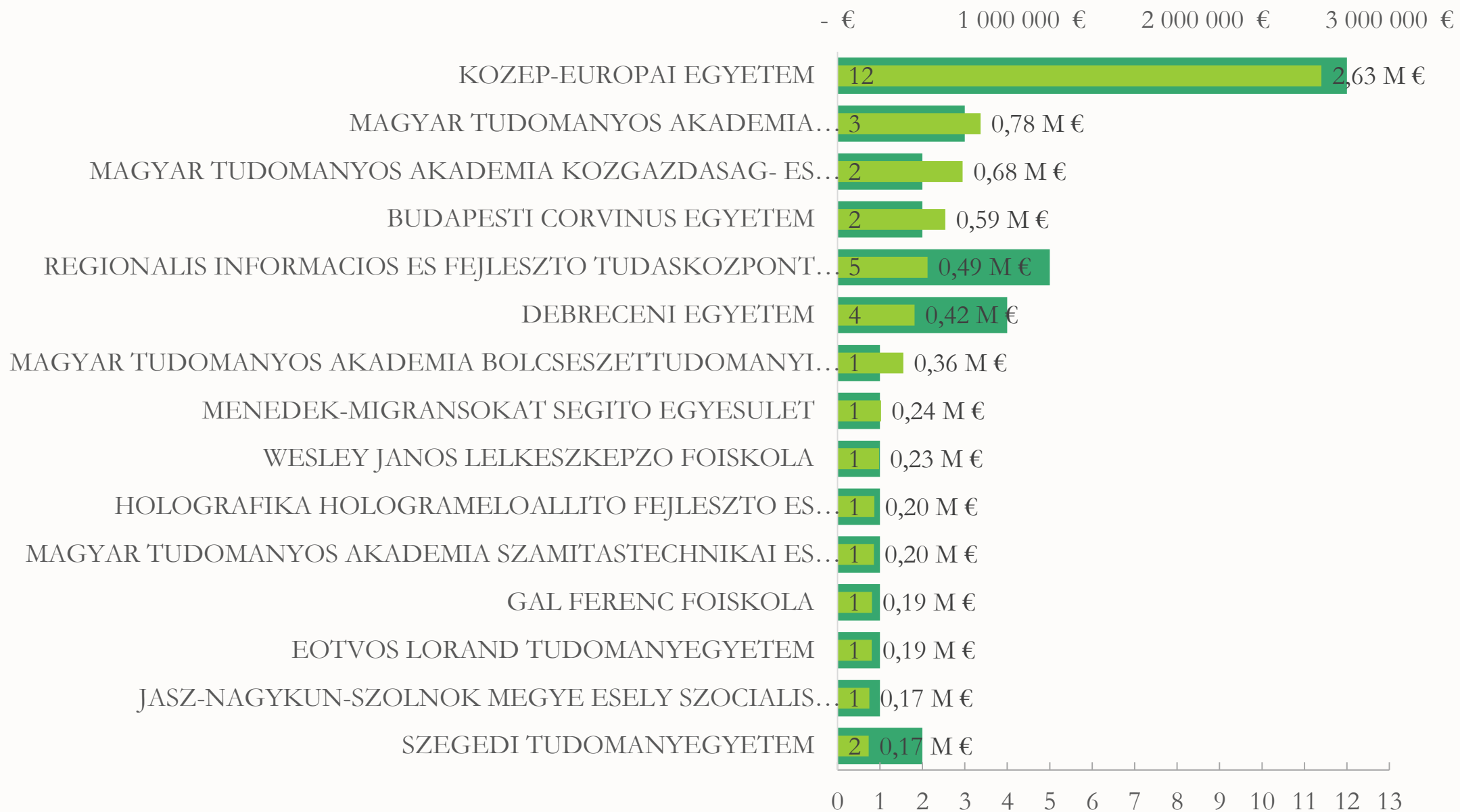
Sikerarányok a pályázati részvételek száma szerint SC6-ban
