- 10.000 synapsis/neuron


## **Face**

- 42 facial muscles
- Axon/muscular fiber proportion!
- Involuntary/emotional/voluntary movements
- Slow atrophy

# **Marginal Mandibular Branch**

- Motor nerve: depressor anguli oris, depressor, labii inferioris, mentalis
- Detection: 12th fetal week; all NMJs: 16th fetal week
  - Terminal branch, under the level of the inferior mandibular border
- To find: mandibular angle and rim, facial artery
- Davis, Sunderland, H-B
- VII. is the most often damaged cranial nerve, MMB is the most often damaged branch.
- Ethnic differences of the anatomy are described







### Major concerns: asymmetry, smile

<u>Positive impact</u>: elderly, family, social activity, positive character, financial security, consequence of the treatment of a major pathology

<u>Negative impact</u>: female sex, other symptomes, communicators, smoking, DM, hypertension

<u>Medical activity</u>: timeline, informations, signs of improvement
