





- The akronim gyakran fog szerepelni a pályázat szövegében, és később gyakran fog majd szóban is azzal utalni a projektre: ezért legyen rövid, könnyen kiejthető és jól hangzó
- Ügyelni kell arra, hogy ne legyen „félreérthető”: sem angolul, sem pedig a kutató, illetve a fogadó intézmény országának az anyanyelvén
- Érdemes ellenőrizni, hogy nem létezik-e már pl. valamilyen vállalat / szervezet / projekt az adott akronimmal:

  - többször is átírásra fog kerülni...
- A megfelelő kapcsolat / együttműködés megteremtése a témavezetővel, ill. a fogadó intézménnyel
  - sok információra lesz tőlük szükség
- Érdemes ellenőrzőlistát készíteni az értékelési kritériumokról
  - és mindegyikre kitérni a pályázatban
- Mindig a FTOP-on elérhető legfrissebb pályázati sablont szükséges használni
- Érdemes másokkal (nem szakértőkkel is) elolvasatni a projektjavaslatot
  - ebből látszik majd, hogy „kívülálló” számára is érthető-e a pályázat
  - „több szem többet lát”: lehetőség szerint érdemes lehet kollégákkal, munkatársakkal, a témavezetővel (az ő munkatársaival), a fogadó intézmény projektirodájával is elolvasatni – különböző szempontok szerint fogják látni

- A projektjavaslat tudományos dolgozatként van megírva – ez a leggyakoribb hiba a PF pályázatok esetében
- A célok és a “state-of-the-art” részletesen ki vannak dolgozva, azonban a pályázat nem fordít elég figyelmet a megvalósításra és a módszertanra, hogy a projekt miben mutat túl az eddigi eredményeken (“beyond-the-state-of-the-art”), illetve a projekt hatásának kidolgozására
- Nem világos célok és célkitűzések (aims & objectives)
- Túlzottan ambiciózus projektjavaslat
- A képzési és karrierfejlesztési szempont elnagyolása
- Nem a pályázati kiírásra szabott CV
- A terjedelmi korlát figyelmen kívül hagyása
- A projektjavaslat nem követi a pályázati struktúrát
- A projektjavaslat figyelmen kívül hagy bizonyos értékelési (al)szempontokat

- Kutatási célok megfogalmazása – mérhetőség, igazolhatóság? Elérhetőek a célok?
- State-of-the-art, és hogyan haladja meg a projektjavaslat? Mennyire ambíciózus a projekt?
- **TIPP**: eredeti, ambíciózus célok, keresztutalások WP-kre.

**TIPP:** Módszertan és kutatási célok kapcsolata!

  - Gender dimenzió, horizontális elvárások:
    - Ha nem releváns a gender – indokolni!

# Értékelési szempontok - Impact
