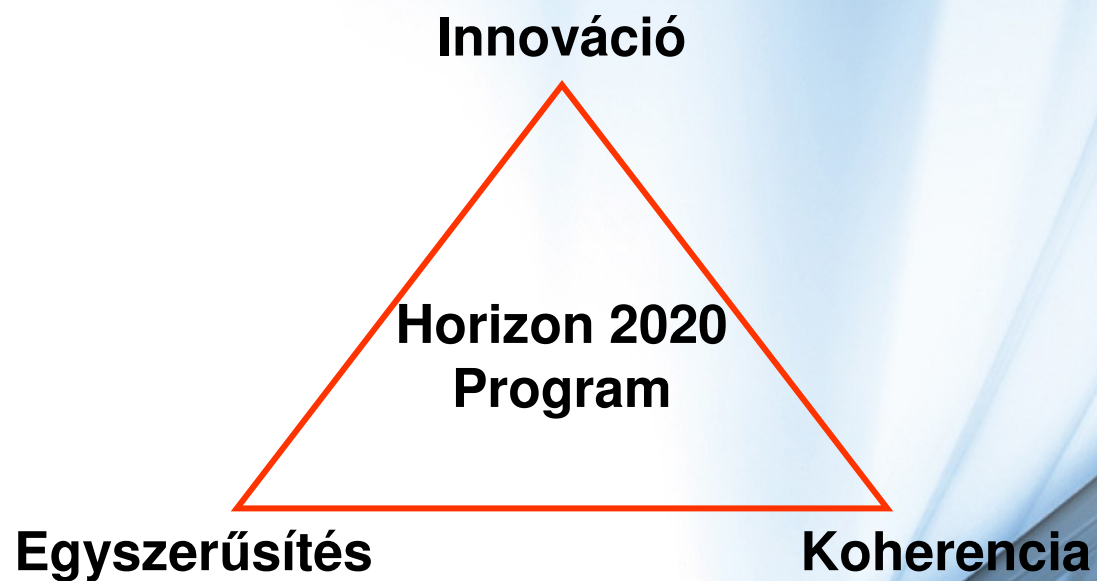

Változások a pályázati folyamatban

1. Pályázatok elbírálásának és a szerződéskötési folyamatnak felgyorsítása – max. 8 hónap
 - 5 hónap – értékelés, pályázók értesítése
 - 3 hónap – szerződéskötés
2. Értékelési folyamat felgyorsítása
 - Értékelők nem tesznek javaslatot a pályázat megváltoztatására
 - A végleges támogatási szerződés szövege a legnagyobb mértékben korreláljon a pályázat I. mellékletével
 - 5 hónap a jogi személyiség validálására
 - FP7es adatok alapul

Kontrollmechanizmusok, audit I.

Pénzügyi fedezet ellenőrzése → legtöbb kedvezményezett mentesül a részletes vizsgálat alól (kivéve a koordinátorok, ha az EU támogatás meghaladja a 500 ezer €-t)

Könyvvizsgálói igazolások → Csak a végelszámolás során, ha az EU támogatás a tényleges költségek alapján meghaladja a 325 000 €-t

Horizon 2020

FP7 and CIP - previous programmes

Horizon 2020 is the new EU funding programme for research and innovation running from 2014 to 2020 with a €70 billion budget. The first calls for proposals for Horizon 2020 are envisaged for **December 2013**. Its simplified rules and submission and grant management tools should facilitate participants' tasks. For practical guidance, see the [H2020 online manual](#).

H2020 supports **SMEs** with a new instrument that runs throughout various funded research and innovation fields, so it should be easy for SMEs to find opportunities in many calls.

H2020 also aims to enhance EU **international research cooperation** so there are more opportunities for Third Country participation.

Having built H2020 around the main societal challenges like an ageing population, food security, energy efficiency, the EU attaches high importance to embed **socio-economic sciences and humanities** into the work programme.

Another important priority of the Commission is to ensure **gender** is embedded in the design of Horizon 2020 project proposals.

FP7 and CIP are previous instruments to fund research and innovation activities in Europe for the period 2007 to 2013. You can view closed calls information of these programmes.

COSME

Programme for the Competitiveness of Enterprises and SMEs (COSME) will run from 2014 to 2020, with a planned budget of €2.3bn. It will facilitate SME access to finance, create supportive environment for business creation, help small businesses operate outside their home countries and improve their access to markets.

H2020 ONLINE MANUAL

The first steps to prepare your proposal and apply for EU research funding. Learn how to find a suitable Call for proposals or project partners and how to submit your proposal.

The following guidance services facilitate your participation:

- **H2020 Online Manual:** step-by-step online guide through the Portal processes from proposal preparation and submission to reporting on your on-going project
- **Reference documents:** library of legal documents, guidance notes, and additional reference material for H2020 and FP7
- **search for already registered organisations and their PICs**
- **Financial viability self-check tool** allows you simulating the financial viability check of your organisation
- **SME participations:** dedicated H2020 guidance page for SME

Step 1 - Find a suitable Call for Proposals

H2020 ONLINE MANUAL

The Commission publishes on the Participant Portal all the Calls of its research and innovation programmes **H2020**, and you can search calls from previous programmes (**FP7** and **CIP**). In addition you can find information about some additional calls in the **Other Funding Opportunities** section. If you apply for the first time and do not know yet the programmes, it is useful to read the H2020 Online Manual. It helps you choose the most suitable programme for your area and profile. Besides, you can **search according to your research topic** with key words and set filters in the calls list.

Your **National Contact Point** can also help you find the most suitable call for your profile. SMEs are in addition supported by the **Enterprise Europe Network**.

Step 2 - Find project partners or apply as an individual team or researcher

Collaborative projects: most of the EU funded projects are collaborative projects with **at least 3 organisations** from different EU Member States or Associated countries. Various **partner search services** help you to find organisations that would like to participate in the proposals. You can also post your collaboration offers there.

Individual researcher or team: It is also possible to submit your proposal as an individual researcher, team or organisation. Such opportunities are mainly funded under the H2020 **European Research Council (ERC) grants** and the **Marie Skłodowska-Curie**
