

Data handling information regarding the nkfi.gov.hu Newsletter service

Pursuant to Article 20 of the Act CXII of 2011 on the right of informative self-determination and the freedom of information (hereinafter referred to as the Info Act), the National Research, Development and Innovation Office (hereinafter referred to as the NRDl Office) renders information to all entities subscribing or having subscribed to the Newsletter service at <http://nkfi.gov.hu/newsletter-registration>, as follows.

1. Legal basis and purpose of data handling

- 1.1 Pursuant to Article 5 (1) a) of the Info Act, the newsletter service of the NRDl Office is disseminated upon the consent of the addressee, with due observance of the provisions set forth by Article 14 of the Act CVIII of 2001 on certain issues of electronic commercial activity and services related to digital society, as well as Article 6 of the Act XLVIII of 2008 on fundamental conditions and respective limits of commercial advertising activity.
- 1.2 The purpose of data handling is to disseminate electronic newsletters to clients, and provide up-to-date information and news on the NRDl Office.

2. Authorised staff to handle data

- 2.1 The newsletter service is supplied by the staff members of the Communications Department, Presidential Secretariat, NRDl Office.

3. Scope of data handled

- 3.1 E-mail address communicated upon subscription to the newsletter and date of subscription.

4. Duration of data handling

- 4.1 Upon the request of the addressee data shall be deleted immediately, or within 30 days if a subscription is not confirmed.

5. Rights and legal remedy of the addressee

- 5.1 The addressee may request his/her personal data to be deleted by clicking on the dedicated link included in the footnote of the newsletter, or sending an e-mail to kommunikacio@nkfi.gov.hu, or via mail forwarded to the NRDl Office, Kéthy Anna tér 1, H-1077 Budapest, Hungary.
- 5.2 Upon the violation of the addressee's rights he/she may
 - a) address the NRDl Office's person in charge for data protection (dr. Eszter Regős, Legal and Administration Department, eszter.regos@nkfi.gov.hu; +36-1-896-3729);
 - b) file lawsuit (Municipal Court of Law, Markó u. 27, H-1055 Budapest);
